Camp Weekend Rules

- Awning to Awning allowed but must not touch and have 6 feet between.
- No open fires permitted. Fires must be contained and not in the grass. Ashes and/or leftover wood must be removed
- Keep area at campsite free of trash
- Respectful parking in your area or close to.
- Insured Golf carts must have site number card from camp office. Licensed driver only. GOLF CARTS ARE <u>NOT</u> ALLOWED ON THE HORSE RACETRACK, ARENA'S OR AROUND RACEHORSE BARNS
- Quiet time is Midnight to 8:00 am- no golf carts out during this time. After dark Golf carts must have lights on.
- All alcoholic beverages must be discrete and kept in coolers.
- Dogs must always be on a leash and cleaned up after. Dangerous dogs and/or excessive barking will not be tolerated.
- All campers must come prefilled with water no water available to fill tanks.
