HOUSEHOLD/FAMILY ENTRIES

Half or less of animal(s) entered may be checked as family/household entries. Family/household animal(s) must be the same animal(s) marked as family/household animal(s) on another family member's entry form. Family/household animal(s) may only be weighed in/shown during the fair by 1 family exhibitor with that entry listed. For a complete description and example visit our website www.miamicountyohiofair.com

All family entered animals must abide by all other general livestock rules and regulations. Household/Family consists of members living within the same household and sharing the same legal address and sharing parents by birth, marriage, adoption or cohabitation. Entered animals may only be checked in and shown by one (1) exhibitor during any and all Junior Shows of current fair year.

NO late entries or entry changes will be accepted after the entry deadline. All identification pictures and other required identification must be submitted with every entry form. The exhibitor that is entering the animal must have actively participated in the care of the project.

Example: Bobby and Betty are siblings and live in the same household. They have 4 goats. Bobby signs up goat #1 and #2 with #3 as a family entry. Betty signs up #4 with #3 as a family entry.

Fair weigh in day is here. Bobby takes goat #1 and #3 to the scales, he now has claimed #3 as his fair project (#2 did not make it to fair)

Betty takes #4 to the scales. She is nice and allows her brother to show #3 since #2 did not get to come to the fair.
