• ALL JUNIOR FAIR ANIMAL EXHIBITORS SHOWING DURING THE 2022 MIAMI COUNTY FAIR MAY BE ENTERED IN THE ONLINE ADD-ON SALE THAT BEGINS August 19, 2022. This includes breeding stock, horses and dogs. During Online Entry creation exhibitors will need to enter the On-Line Add On found as a Department to be included.

2022 Release of animal Information:

4-H or FFA HORSE PROJECTS will be released on Wednesday, August 17th at the close of fair (11:00 pm) -7:00 am Thursday. Those who choose to stay Thursday due to other planned events are required to remain on the grounds until released by the department chair.

General Rules

- 1. Shows will follow the Ohio State Equine Rulebook.
- 2. Each project animal will be awarded an exhibition award.
 - a. \$4.00 youcher that can be redeemed at the fair office before Friday Aug. 19 at 5:00 pm.
- 3. Only Junior Horse show exhibitors will be allowed to ride or school horses in or around the arena on Monday, Tuesday, and Wednesday until after the show is over for the day.
- 4. All Junior Horse Show Classes will be judged under the rules as outlined in 4-H Circular No. 179 State Uniform Rules for 4-H Horse Shows and all 4-H policies, rules, and regulations will apply.
- 5. Mare with foals or fouls are not permitted at the Miami County Fair.
- 6. All horses stalled at the fair must be participating in the Miami County Fair.
- 7. Animals must remain in place until Thursday at 6:00 pm.
 - a. Anyone leaving early without written permission from the superintendent will not be permitted to exhibit the following year.
- 8. Anyone 4H age and younger must wear a helmet anytime they are on a horse.
- 9. No horses are to be turned loose at any time.
- 10. Stalls must be kept clean and presentable.
- 11. Upon departure all stalls must be stripped and all decorations should be taken down.
- 12. No screws or nails are to be used on stalls.
- 13. Sleeping in the barn overnight is prohibited.
- 14. No running in the barn.
- 15. Keep the wash rack clean and free of debris
- 16. All manure must be dumped in the designated location.

Entries / Possession

- 17. Horses must have been owned and in the exhibitor's care by June 1.
- 18. Leases must have been on file with the Extension Office by June 1 of the current year.
- 19. All online horse entries are due on or before June 1, 2022.
- 20. Project animals must have been listed on horse entry form; there will be no production classes at the 2022 Miami County Fair.
- 21. Any entry changes for height or exhibitor age must be brought to the Junior Fair Office no later than 5 pm on Saturday, August 13, 2022.
 - a. Advisors will be notified of any changes.
- 22. Novice classes will be determined by the seat.

23. Novice Walk-Trot Class

- a. Open to all age groups and heights.
- b. Rider may not have shown in a three gaited (walk/trot/canter) or easy gaited class.
- c. Any member placing 1st or 2nc in this class will be ineligible for this class in the future; but will be eligible for Novice 3-Gaited.

- d. May not cross enter into age group classes and are not eligible for championship classes.
- e. Members are limited to 3 consecutive years of participation in this class.
- f. Riders may only participate in Western/English Novice, Showmanship, Hitch classes.
 - i. Not eligible for contesting classes or over fences.

24. Novice Class (Western /English 3-Gaited and Showmanship)

- a. Open to all age groups and heights.
- b. Novice riders must have had extremely limited 3-gaited showing/riding experience.
- c. Riders may only participate in Western/English Novice, Showmanship, Hitch classes.
 - i. Not eligible for contesting or over fences
- d. May not cross enter into age group classes and are not eligible for championship classes.
- e. Members are limited to 2 consecutive years of participation in this class.
- f. Any member placing 1st or 2nc in this class will be ineligible for this class in the future.

25. Ranch Horse

- a. The same horse can not be entered in Ranch Showmanship and Western Showmanship.
- b. The same horse can not be entered in Ranch Horsemanship and Westerns Horsemanship.
- c. Other rules will follow the state rulebook.

Equine / Show

- 26. Chaps in Horsemanship classes are optional.
- 27. Small equines must be measured in order to participate in small equine classes. If not measured, they are subjected to be moved up a height class.
 - a. Small equines can be measured prior to the show on Monday, Tuesday, or Wednesday between 8:00am and 8:30am.
- 28. Classes with an excessive number of entries may be split or combined at the discretion of the judge and superintendent.
- 29. Time limit for entering the gate: 2 minutes after the first horse enters the gate.
- 30. Any official protest will cost \$50.00 and must accompany a written protest before the close of the show.
 - a. Protesters must be an exhibitor in the class being protested.

Sharing Horses

- 31. The following guidelines and restrictions established in the policy on horse sharing must be followed.
 - a. 4H / FFA members (siblings only) may share one (1) equine exhibit/entry at the Miami County Fair.
 - b. Only one sibling may participate in PAS and try to Qualify for State fair with a shared horse project.
 - c. The shared horse is a 4H project for both individuals and must be completed by both participants, separately.

32. Classes

- a. A single horse can only be shown in 7 classes per day, excluding championship classes.
- d. A shared horse may only be exhibited one time per class.
- e. In the event that multiple siblings qualify for a Championship Class, the family must decide what sibling will participate.
 - i. Examples:
 - 1. Western Showmanship 16 -18: If the siblings are 16 and 18 only one participant may show the horse in this class.
 - 2. Western Showmanship: If a 13-year-old and 18-year-old win their class and qualify for the championship class then the family must decide who shows the horse, both participants cannot show in this class.

f. Sibling Definition:

i. Household/family consists of living within the same household and sharing the same legal address and sharing parents by birth, marriage, adoption or cohabitation.
